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Free Bear Basket Crochet Pattern



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This free crochet pattern gives you a cute little storage basket that is perfect for the kids' room or the changing table. The basket is crocheted with [Infinity Hearts Amigurumi](#).



Measurements

The basket measures approx. 14.5cm in diameter and 6.5cm in height. You can continue the last round if you want the basket to be taller.

Materials

- [Crochet Hook](#) size 3.50mm
- [Tapestry Needle](#)
- Possibly [Scissors](#)

Yarn consumption

- 1 skein of [Infinity Hearts Amigurumi 10 Dark Brown](#)
- 1 skein of [Infinity Hearts Amigurumi 08 Beige](#)
- 1 skein of [Infinity Hearts Amigurumi 02 Black](#)

Abbreviations

MR – magic ring

dc – double crochet

sl st – slip stitch

ch - chain stitch

2 in the next – 2 dc in the same stitch

x(number) – repeat x number of times

- - repeat entire round

Tip:

You can attach the muzzle with sewing thread so that it will be less visible on the basket

Bonus Tip:

The basket can also be used for storing pacifiers.

Instructions



The basket itself:

Round 1. 6 dc in MR (6)

Round 2. *2 dc in each s* (12)

Round 3. *1 dc, 2 in the next* (18)

Round 4. *2 dc, 2 in the next* (24)

Round 5. *3 dc, 2 in the next* (30)

Round 5. 2 dc, 2 in the next, *4 dc, 2 in the next* x5, 2 dc (36)

Round 6. *5 dc, 2 in the next* (42)

Round 7. 3 dc, 2 in the next, *6 dc, 2 in the next* x5, 3 dc (48)

Round 8. *7 dc, 2 in the next* (54)

Round 9. *8 dc, 2 in the next* (60)

Round 10. *9 dc, 2 in the next* (66)

Round 11. *10 dc, 2 in the next* (72)

Round 12. 6 dc, 2 in the next, *11 dc, 2 in the next* x5, 1 dc in the next 5 s (78)

Round 13. *12 dc, 2 in the next* (84)

Round 14. *13 dc, 2 in the next* (90)

Round 15. 8 dc, 2 in the next, *14 dc, 2 in the next* x5, 1 dc in the next 6 s (96)

Round 16. A dc in the back loop of each s (96)

Round 17-28. 1 dc in each s (96)

Round 29. 1 round with 1 sl st in each s (96)

Ears (2 pcs):

Round 1. 6 dc in MR (6)



You now crochet rows.

Rw 2. 2 dc in the first 3 s (6) 1 ch and turn

You don't work with the last 3 stitches

Rw 3. *1 dc, 2 in the next* x3 (9) 1 ch and turn

Rw 4. *2 dc, 2 in the next* x3 (12) 1 ch and turn

Rw 5. *3 dc, 2 in the next* x3 (15) 1 ch and turn

Rw 6. 1 dc in each + along the "edge" – You can then choose to make a round with sl st all the way around for the ear to have a thicker and more enhanced edge.

Attach the ears with a space of approx. 14 stitches.

Muzzle:

Make 9 ch

Rw 1. 2 dc in 2 s from the hook, 1 dc in the next s, 3 dc in the last s, continue on the other side, 1 dc in each until the start of the round (18)

Rw 2. 2 dc in the next 3 s, 4 dc, 2 dc in the next 3 s, 1 dc in the last s until the start of the round (24)

Rw 3. 1 dc in the next 4 s, 2 dc in the next 9 s, 1 dc in the next 3 s, 2 dc in the next 7 s, 1 dc in the last s (40)

Rw. 4. 1 dc in each s, finish with 1 sl st in next (40)

Embroider a nose with black yarn at the top centre of the muzzle.

Attach the muzzle to the "middle" of the basket between the ears and sew it on using regular stitches



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
